Susan Tilton Pecora

Nationally known artist Susan Tilton Pecora lives and paints in the village of Thorndike, MA where she maintains a studio in an old mill building on the river. Pecora is a signature member of New England Watercolor Society and the host of the PBS affiliate WGBY show "Reflections Through Watercolor". Her work is included in the collection of the Smithsonian Museum and in private and corporate collections throughout the United States and Europe. She has created paintings for Willie Nelson's Farm Aid Concert, First Night in Northampton, The Mattoon Street Art Festival 35th Anniversary Poster, and the Newbury Street Gallery Guide in Boston.

Barbara S. Groff, PSA Master

Barbara is known for her award-winning still life paintings and the ability to accomplish remarkable detail using the traditional pastel medium. After a successful career as a graphic designer, she turned full-time professional painter in 2002. A Connecticut native and largely self-educated fine artist, she has garnered numerous awards for her pastel paintings, including the Dianne B. Bernhard Gold Medal Award in Pastel. In 2008 she was featured in the Pastel Journal magazine as one of the top five winners overall in their 9th Annual Pastel 100 competition. She is a designated Master Pastelist and Signature Member of the Pastel Society of America, Inc.; an elected artist of the Allied Artists of America, Inc.; and a signature member of the Connecticut Pastel Society. Since 2007 she has been listed in Who's Who in American Art.

 - Acrylics
 - Oils
 - Watercolors
 - Pastels
 - Other Media (pencil drawing, charcoals, pen and inks, block prints, collage, encaustics)
- Original art only. Jury selections will be based on the review of the original artworks, rather than on slides or jpegs.
- Wired for hanging with frame
- Wired Frame edge-to-edge max 20x24
- No saw-tooth/clip hangers
- 5% contribution from artist for art sold. (Art may be marked NFS.)
- Non-refundable¹ entry fee.
 - \$25 **preregistration per entry** by Oct.15, 2011 Sat.
 - \$30 after Oct. 15

Liability: All reasonable care and safety will be exercised in the handling, hanging, and storing of the art submitted. The Friends of the Agawam Public Library, the Library, and the Town of Agawam will not be responsible for loss or damage to any item submitted.
