In the event of an EARLY DISMISSAL or CANCELLATION OF AFTERNOON/EVENING programs at the Agawam Public Schools, afternoon and evening children's and teen programs will be CANCELED. Morning programs will run as scheduled"

GUIDELINES:

- Writers must be in grades 1 to 12.
- Poem entries must be original work.
- Maximum of 1 poem per author may be entered.
- Poems cannot be longer than one 8 1/2 X 11 inch page.
- Poems must be typed or hand-written on white paper, with no illustrations or decorations.
- The author's name must not appear anywhere on the poem.
- The poem must have a title that should be at the top of the page.

DEADLINE:

- **Entries will be taken April 1st – April 30th, 2019.**
Entries must be received by 8:00 p.m. on Monday, April 30th. Entries cannot be put in the book drop. E-mail entries will not be accepted.

Poems will be judged based on Spelling, Grammar, Style & Presentation, Impact, and Originality.

Contest winners will be announced May 28th, 2019.

All entries will be bound into a book for viewing at the library.
