Student Poetry Contest **for Grades 1-12** **April 1st – 30th.**

GUIDELINES:

- * Writers must be in grades 1 to 12.
- * Poem entries must be original work.
- * One poem per author may be entered.
- * Poems cannot be longer than one 8 1/2 X 11 inch page.
- * Poems must be typed or hand-written on white paper, with no illustrations or decorations.
- * The author's name must not appear anywhere on the poem.
- * The poem must have a title that should be at the top of the page.

DEADLINE:

Entries will be taken April 1st – April 30th, 2019.

Entries cannot be put in the book drop. E-mail entries will not be accepted.

Poems will be judged based on Spelling, Grammar, Style & Presentation, Impact, and Originality.

Contest winners will be announced May 29th, 2020.

All entries will be bound into a book for viewing at the library.
