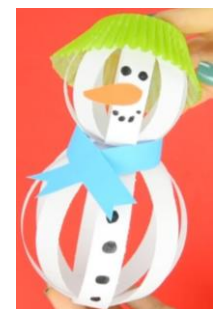
## **KRAFTY KIDS STAND-UP SNOWMAN For grades 5-12**

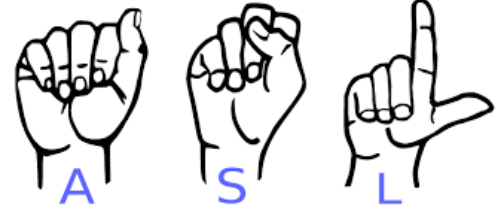
