Later she started working at the circulation desk and went from part time to full time.

Currently Laura works at the Information Desk and wherever else she might be needed. Like all the rest of the library's staff, Laura's responsibilities are many, and diversified. She made the flyer and bookmarks that are distributed, she orders eBooks and eAudio books, and helps patrons download these to their devices. She also manages the library's Twitter page. Laura is one of the people who will be working to create and organize some new groups for library patrons.

Laura's favorite part of her job is seeing all the new books, music, DVDs, magazines, etc. that come in to the library. (I think we've heard this before-it seems to be part of the passion that fuels our very exceptional

Library staff!)

Laura is clearly proud of the library's response to the pandemic. She noted that they started early on to provide curbside pickup, which involves setting up four tables full of holds on three days of the week. The library is open for browsing and computer use for three days a week-more than any of the other libraries in the area.

On a more personal note, some of Laura's favorite authors include Neil Gaiman, Joshilyn Jackson, Fredrik Backman, Isabel Allende and Elizabeth Strout. She is clearly devoted to her work and passionate about the Agawam library and all it provides. 
